
The W295 Series Mini-Crawler immediately sets itself apart from other mini-crawler cranes. Originally designed

to work efficiently in the close proximities of Japan, the W295 can easily maneuver through a space as narrow as a doorframe, and lift up to three tons with its boom. Multiple power source options (gasoline, gasoline and electric, or diesel) are ideal for jobs in the great outdoors or restricted to confined, indoor spaces. Caterpillar tracks grant the W295 greater accessibility to a variety of terrain, and the "spider-like" design of the legs ensures flexibility and stability unknown to other small cranes.

The advanced technology of its design brings a list of features and unique benefits previously unknown to the mini-crane industry:

- 24 inches wide, allowing access to locations and terrain once considered inaccessible.
- Smooth-running, rubber crawler treads.
- "Spider design" has adjustable four-legged outrigger for maximum stability and terrain access.
- Simple controls, all in one place, ensures efficiency in operations.
- Available remote-control options for increased human safety in hazardous environments.
- Automatic hook-stow secures the hook firmly in place.
